What Is Considered Electronic Waste (E-Waste)?

Electronic waste, or e-waste, includes any item that uses electricity or batteries. Common examples are:



- TVs and monitors
- Desktop computers and laptops
- Printers, scanners, and fax machines
- Cell phones and tablets
- Microwaves and small kitchen appliances

These items often contain hazardous materials like mercury, lead, and cadmium, which is why **Utah enforces strict disposal regulations**.

What Can Go in a Driveway Safe Dumpster?

While electronics are off-limits, you can safely dispose of:


1. General household waste (paper, plastics, old textiles)
2. Furniture (chairs, tables, couches)*
3. Landscaping waste (leaves, grass, small branches)
4. Open, dried-out paint cans

**Note: Mattresses and box springs can be included for a \$20 fee each.*

Here are some items we can't accept in any of our containers:

 Item	 Reason
TVs, computers, phones	Environmental risk, e-waste regulations
Batteries	Fire and explosion hazard
Food waste	Attracts pests, not landfill-safe
Refrigerators (fee: \$50)	Contains refrigerants
Wet paint & chemicals	Toxic and flammable
Ammunition or explosives	Safety risk
Bricks, concrete, dirt	Too heavy; can damage dumpsters/driveway
